Name: The blue tit

Food: It feeds essentially on insects, on larvae, on eggs of caterpillar, on bugs, aphids ... But it feeds on berries, on seeds and on buds the rest of the year.

Sound: It « zinzinule ».

Gender: It is omnivore.

Habitat: It is in a cosy and thick nest (dry grass, moss, feather, cobweb). It nests in a hole of tree. In winter, it can also live in a breeding ground.

There is between 5 in 12 eggs in the nest. They are very small and are white, beige sometimes with blackheads. The female hatches them approximately 15 days and the male takes care of the provisioning.
