Name: The pigeon

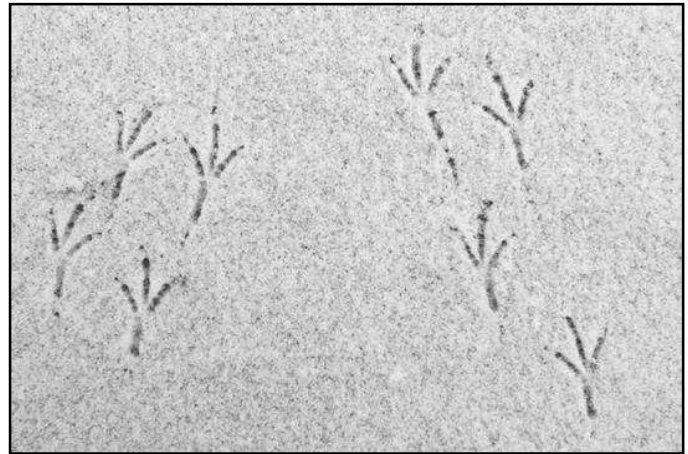
