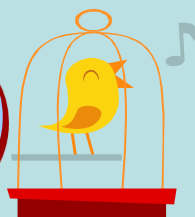

SOUND



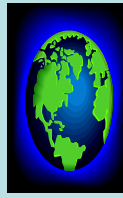
- Every Eurasian eagle-owl has a different sound.

- Length: 50-72cm
- Height: 67 cm
- Wingspan: 1'5-1'8 m

WHERE DO YOU LIVE?



- They live in Asia, Europe and Africa.
- Normally they live at mountains.

WHERE DO YOU NEST?



- They can nest directly on the floor.
- They build the nest in rocky places.



MALE VS FEMALE



- The male looks for the food. —————→
- Weight: 2-2'7 kg —————→



- While the female feeds and protects the babies.
- Weight: 2'5-3'2 kg

CIRCLE OF LIFE



- The babies have white feathers.
- They lay 1-6 eggs once per year.
- Incubation period: 32-35 days.
- 80% of babies will die in the first year.
- In two months the babies can fly.

HOW TO RECOGNIZE THIS BIRD?



- They have feathers in both sides of their heads.
- They have orange eyes.
- They are big.

OTHER INFORMATION



- They are used for falconry.
- The scientific name is based on the sound they make.
- They hunt and live during nights.
- It is the biggest nocturnal bird of prey.
- They can kill other owls and birds of prey.
- They live during 15-20 years, but they can live 50-60 years if they are in captivity.
- They defecate in the rocks in order to mark their territory.
